Peters Surf Boat Survival Series 2007-2008

Series Rules

Central Coast, Hunter and Lower North Coast clubs are invited to compete in the 2007-2008 Peters Surf Boat Survival Series.

Set out below are the rules and conditions of entry to the series and entries from clubs will only be accepted with crews agreeing to compete under these rules.

Competition Rules

1. **Report time** for the series will be from 7am to 7.30am. If you have not signed on **by 7.30am** you and yours crews will miss the first round.
2. Each round will **start at 8am** sharp
3. A **Sweep/Team Managers meeting** will take place with the Referee at each round at **7.30am**.
4. Clubs will draw a number in each round. That number is to be adopted by all crews from that club in that round. Each round following will allow for a new draw.
5. All rounds run with 3 heats with the top **six to go to the final**. Points for day allocated on finals placing's only. Points allocated at the end of the day from 8 down to 1.
6. **Note:** On entry forms, competitors names must be grouped into crews with the division entered for clearly marked. If a club has more than one crew in a division, each crew must be identified with a name eg. Gold, Rats etc. and that **crew must keep that name for the whole series**. This will eliminate confusion in point's allocation.
7. The age limit for both Women's and Men's Masters is set at a minimum 140years division (no 120years crews).
8. If a club wishes to enter more than one Reserve Crew at each round, there must be a competing A Crew from that Club. **No double dipping of divisions allowed by crews.**
9. Sweeps will be supplied with a Lycra singlet. They are to be worn during all competition. Failure to do so will result in a loss of points under the discretion of the Surf Sports Director, Central Coast.

10. All other regulations as set out in the Surf Life Saving Australia competition manual will apply.
11. Categories will comprise Under 19, Under 23, Under 23 Ladies, Open Women's, Open Men, Reserves, Masters Women's, Masters Men's.
12. Only Surf Life Saving – Central Coast, Newcastle and Lower North Coast clubs will be eligible to contest the series.
13. Racing order on day will be; Masters Men's, Masters Women's, U/21, U/23 Ladies, Reserves, U/23 Men's, Open Women's and Opens.
14. **Officials Quota:** Each competing club is asked to supply at least one accredited official for each round of the series. The Referee/Chief Judge will allocate positions on the day.

Note: The elected boat panel or their proxies will address any problems on the day and report back to the referee for direction.

Administration

Entry Fees \$110 per crew for the series including GST. A late entry fee of \$50 per club will be charged.

Entries On Surf Lifesaving carnival entry form, together with entry fees to Surf Lifesaving – Central Coast, at PO Box 5029, Chittaway Bay NSW 2261.

Entries close on Friday September 21st 2007 and a late entry fee of \$50 per club in addition to the entry fee will be charged for entries not received by that date.

Sponsorship As the series is sponsored by Nestle/Peters all **sweeps** will be required to wear sponsor singlets each race. Crews will be given a sponsors t-shirt once entry fees paid.

Crews competing undertake to do so with no signage on equipment or crew attire that could in any way conflict with the interests of the series sponsor – Nestle/Peters. The interpretation of the series race director will be final in this regard.

Crews are required to display Sponsors stickers on boats if supplied.

Prizes All competitors and judges will receive series shirts. Prizes will be to the value of \$8,000 and include:
